ELIGIBILITY

The festival is open to individual artists selling original artwork in a variety of mediums. No dealers, agents or representatives are permitted. Eligible Media includes: Ceramics, Drawing, Fiber, Glass, Jewelry, Metalwork, Mixed Media, Painting, Photography, Printmaking, Sculpture, Wood.

HOW TO ENTER: 6' x 2' Table or 10' x 10' Booth

6' x 2' Table: Individual tables for non-profits, organizations, and artists who may not have an ample amount of work or are just starting out in selling and displaying their work at festivals. Each participant is given a 6' x 2' table and two chairs under the large Artist's Tent. Participants can bring additional small displays for the top of tables and behind them.

10' x 10' Booth: A 10' x 10' tent for those who have more work than would fit on a 6'x2' table, and who have previous festival experience. Participating artists must provide their own tent, chairs, and display props.

This year's festival will be held outdoors. There will not be an alternative "rain site." Artists should be prepared for inclement weather (example: warm clothing, protective packaging materials for art, etc.).

- Complete appropriate application.
- Submit 2 digital images that best represent your work. Label images with your First and Last name and number. Example: James Smith 01.jpg. Images can be submitted via a CD, saved on a USB thumb drive, or emailed to blandenmemorial@gmail.com.

FEES

Table Fee: A 6' x 2' table inside the Artist's Tent for \$40 each. \$30 for Blanden Art Museum Members and currently enrolled college students with an ID.

Booth Fee: A 10' x 10' booth (you must provide your own) for \$65 each. \$55 for Blanden Art Museum Members and currently enrolled college students with an ID.

PUBLICITY

The Blanden Art Museum is committed to developing a strong audience of support for participating artists. The event will be widely marketed through print ads, radio promotions, online advertising, Facebook and a host of other media.

SALES AND TAX INFORMATION

It is the responsibility of the artists to charge and collect 6% lowa state sales tax. A copy of the artist's sales tax permit must be available at the booth at all times. Artists retain all revenue from the sale of their work. The Blanden Art Museum does not take any portion of Artist Sales.
